SPLOST FUNDING

WATER TREATMENT PLANT FUNDING

We are thrilled to share some fantastic news about our city's Water Sewer Infrastructure Project.

Thanks to the tireless efforts of our City Accountant and our City Administrator, we have successfully secured additional funding through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). After diligent work, including providing detailed documentation and maintaining open communication with Hunter Hill, we are overjoyed to announce that our city has been awarded an increased ARPA grant of \$6,045,848.00. This grant is nearly double our initial grant award.

This significant increase will help us address cost overruns caused by recent economic challenges, ensuring the successful completion of our Water Treatment Plant development. It's important to note that these funds are a gift to our community, requiring no repayment.

We are incredibly grateful for the hard work and dedication of our City Accountant and our City Administrator. Their efforts will have a lasting positive impact on our city's infrastructure and the well-being of our residents.

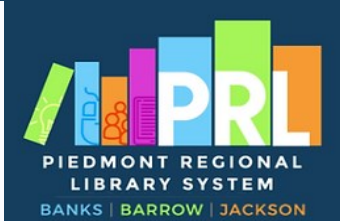
