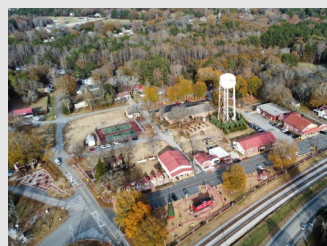

FAQ: New Trash Service Rates and Options in the City of Auburn



Q: Why did the trash service rates increase on April 1, 2023?

A: Republic Services proposed the increase in trash services to the City at the contract renewal. Their reasoning for the increase was caused by inflation, supply chain disruptions, and overall costs incurred by Republic Services to provide their services.

Q: What did the City of Auburn do to negotiate the rate increase on behalf of the citizens?

A: The City took over the billing aspect of trash services, which helped to keep the rate increase to a minimum. As a result, Auburn's trash service rates remain below those of many neighboring communities.

Q: What happened to recycling services in the new contract?

A: Curbside recycling services were discontinued by Republic Services in the new contract. However, recycling is still available in the City at no charge. A recycling container is located directly behind City Hall for citizens to bring their recyclables free of charge.

Q: Are bulk pickups still available?

A: Yes, bulk pickups are still available. You can schedule one by calling Republic Services at 678-963-2873.

Q: Who should I contact for customer service regarding trash services?

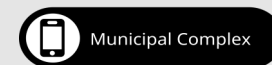

Q: I have prepaid for trash services with Republic Services before the change. What will happen to my payment?

A: If you have prepaid your trash services with Republic Services prior to this change, Republic will issue you a refund within the coming weeks. As of April 1, 2023, you will begin paying your trash bill directly to the City of Auburn.

Q: Why can't we choose our own trash service?

A: The City Code provides for one service provider for the entire City. This is intended to keep rates low, to avoid multiple trash services passing through neighborhoods with trash cans constantly out on different days, and to limit truck traffic and wear and tear on the City roads.

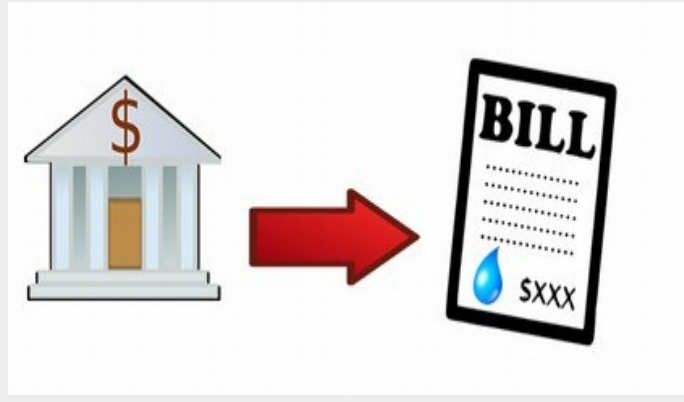
