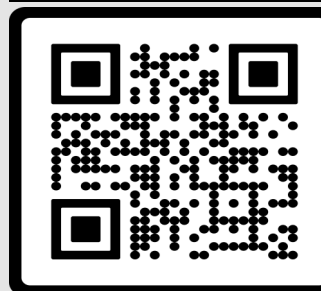

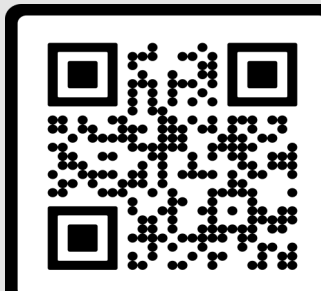

Wishing you all a joyful and fulfilling holiday season, filled with the love and support of our wonderful Auburn community.

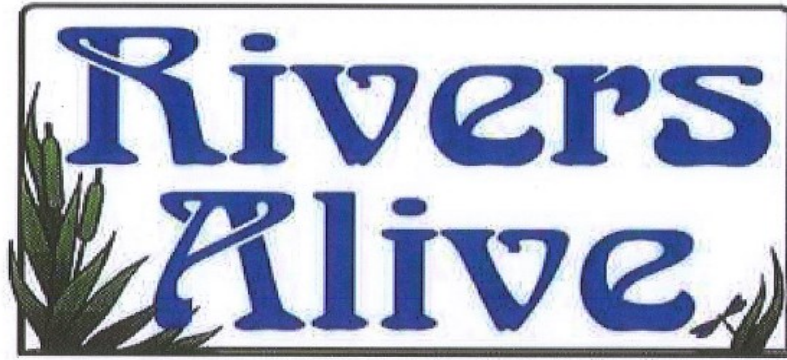
