RIVERS ALIVE is Georgia's annual volunteer waterway cleanup event that targets all waterways in the state, including streams, rivers, lakes, beaches, and wetlands.

The mission of **Rivers Alive** is to create awareness of and involvement in the preservation of Georgia's water resources. Rivers Alive is held annually each fall and is a Georgia Environmental Protection Division Outreach Program project.

Volunteer registration is now open for Georgia's annual clean-up initiative, October 12, 2024. The clean-up will take place from 8:00 AM to 11:00 AM at Shackelford Park located at 476 Brown Bridge Road, Auburn.

All volunteers must wear closed-toe shoes and long pants, and bring gloves, water, and insect repellent. Also, volunteers must have the Rivers Alive volunteer waiver form completed and signed at the beginning of the event.
